

## CALL FOR PAPERS

### ***RULES FOR REGISTRATION***

The extended abstracts must be written concisely, with accuracy and conceptual clarity and techniques necessary for their understanding, within 4 (four) pages.

The texts can be written in Portuguese, Spanish or English.

The font must be Times New Roman, size 12, 1.5 spacing format, 2 cm margin in each side of the document, justified and without splitting words at the end of the line. Please, use the ABNT's formatting standards ([www.abnt.org.br](http://www.abnt.org.br)).

**Title:** it must provide a precise idea of the content and be as short as possible, written in uppercase, size 12 and centered.

**Authors:** they must always be put in the correct order, without inversions, with the last name capitalized and aligned. The paper will be accepted at least with one (1) main author and a maximum of four (4) co-authors, reaching a total of five (5). The main author can only register one (1) expanded abstract. After the authors' names, it should be written their institutional links, only with the first author's email.

The expanded abstract must be subdivided into the following sections: Introduction, including references which justify the paper, and the objective at the end; Material and Method; Discussion; Conclusions; and References.

On the first page, it must also be indicated as a footnote (font Times New Roman, size 10) the paper's thematic axis.

**Illustrations:** tables and figures must be limited to what is necessary, numbered in Arabic numerals and inserted in the text. The subtitles must be self-explanatory and placed above the tables and below the figures.

Avoid vertical lines in the tables.

Do not use bold font style in the text.

**Electronic File:** The files with the extended abstracts must be sent in ' .doc ' format. The expanded abstracts will only be evaluated and published in the Workshop's annals after the payment be confirmed.

The accepted papers will be published in the electronic annals (Flash Drive) with ISSN.

The rules will be applied to all without distinction: round-tables, oral communication and banners.

The rules for making the banners can be found in the template for this purpose. They must be single size, 1.2 m long and 1 m wide, with all informations from the expanded abstract.
